However, this is the first FIFA Women's World Cup with more than one host nation, as Australia and New Zealand are jointly hosting it. It is also the first FIFA Women's World Cup to be held in the Southern Hemisphere. The first match was played in AUCKland, New Zealand, as the host team played (and won!) against Norway on July 20th. Co-host AUStralia played later the same evening, beating Ireland in Sydney. In June this year, FIFA announced the prizes for all

participating nations. This edition's total prize pool is Jubilant scenes after Japan's defeat of Spain.

US\$110 million, almost four times greater than the prize pool of the previous tournament! The winning team received over ten million dollars of that, split between each player and their nation's football association.

The highest prize money ever! In the end, the best team always wins, and that title belongs to **Spain**. They played magnificently and the team deserves all the glory (and prize money!) they get. Many Kiwis and Australians have now come to love football even more because of this tournament. I hope our teams do even better in four years!
